

FROM THE OFFICE OF THE LEADER C4C IN PARLIAMENT

My attention has been drawn to two separate but related correspondences dated Wednesday 29th July 2020 addressed to the Leader of Government Business and Clerk of Parliament respectively. The contents of the said correspondences speak to the subject of my removal as Leader of C4C in Parliament and the selections of some colleague C4C MPs to serve in different capacities in Parliamentary Committees.

Let me from the outset state that, I, Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina continues to be the legitimate and recognized leader of C4C in parliament. This is predicated on the fact that, the purported Secretary General who signed the correspondences does not possess the legal standing to do so.

Let it be known that the power to distribute MPs into Parliamentary Committee is reserved for the selection Committee alone as stated in Standing Orders 70 Sub-section 1 (b). So with this in mind, no Political Party has a say in how Committees are constituted in Parliament.

Let me once more re-assure the general membership of C4C as well as the people of Sierra Leone that as Leader of C4C in Parliament, I will continue to give political directions to the party in Parliament in order to fulfill the mandate which the people of Sierra Leone have bestowed upon us.
