The COVID-19 Vaccination is continuing across the country. To date a total of 32,711 people have been vaccinated with their first dose. The vaccination exercise will continue in all the static vaccination sites across the country from Tuesday 6th April, 2021.

For Cabinet Ministers and Senior Government Officials that are due to receive their second dose on the 5th April at state house as stated in their vaccination cards, a mobile vaccination team will be available at State House on Wednesday 7th April, 2021, starting at 10 am.

For those that received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine at the Miatta Conference hall, please go for your second dose at any of the static vaccination sites anywhere in the country.

Irrespective of where you received your 1st dose, you can receive your second dose at any of the static vaccination sites in the country on the due date stated in your vaccination card.
