Joint Statement by MOHS, SLMDA, JUDASIL and SLMWA

Following series of meetings held between senior officials of the Ministry of Health and Sanitation (MOHS) and the executives of Sierra Leone Medical and Dental Association (SLMDA), Junior Doctors' Association of Sierra Leone and Sierra Leone (JUDASIL), Sierra Leone Medical Women's Association (SLMWA), we hereby wish to jointly present the following resolutions:

- That all parties acknowledge the challenges in the healthcare delivery system and have resolved to work together to address these challenges; including concerns of doctors and other healthcare workers.
- That the MoHS guarantees the safety of all its employees including doctors and all healthcare workers; and that all parties condemn unacceptable conduct by any official of the Ministry against any person or group of persons.
- That we acknowledge actions have so far been taken to address the sanitation and other related challenges at the Connaught Hospital.
- 4. That MoHS will constitute an Independent Committee to investigate the unfortunate and regrettable incident that occurred on the 13th April 2021 at Connaught Hospital and we await the Committee's findings and recommendations, while all parties are assured that such will not recur.
- That the SLMDA will inform its membership to resume work, following the signing of this statement by all parties involved.
