## STATEMENT FROM THE UNITED MINE WORKERS UNION KINGHO TONKOLILI MINE SITE

We register our profound dismay over the preliminary statement released by CRSG, a sub contractor of the Kingho Mining Company in relation to unfortunate incident that took place yesterday, 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2021. The United Mine Workers Union (UMU) of the aforementioned company unanimously condemn the Prejudgment, bias and cheap propaganda statement of CRSG Company. It is outrageous, indecent and unfounded to justify who started the fight. Such is sarcastic and prejudicing justice.
