

TWENTY-ONE (21) DAYS STRIKE NOTICE

I wish to inform you that at a National Executive Council held on the 21st August 2021, it was resolved that the union issues a Twenty-One (21) days strike notice to SIERRATEL

- Non-payment of salary for three months
- Incomplete payment of 2020 Leave Allowances
- Non-payment of 2021 Leave Allowances
- Non-payment of NASSIT contributions for two years
- No promotion for over ten years
- Non-implementation of wage re-opener of 2020
- Poor medical facility for staff in the western area and No medical for
- Unavailability of materials to carry out repairs on damages for work
- Non-payment of Union dues for over four months
- No tools for work
- Unhealthy working environment
- No uniform for female staff for two years
- Delay in payment of Terminal benefits to retired and bereaved families for

As you are aware, several meetings have been held with your Management, consultations with other stakeholders where your management made promises and gave assurances to address the situation thereto, but yet the issues remained unresolved.

This letter therefore serves as Twenty-One (21) Days Strike Notice, effective 24th August, 2021. Workers will therefore go on strike should the issues contained in this letter remain unresolved on the expiration of the Twenty-one (21) days.
