PAYMENT OF FIRST TERM TUITION FEES FOR PUPILS IN GOVERNMENT AND GOVERNMENT-ASSISTED SCHOOLS FOR THE 2021/2022 ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR

The Ministry of Finance (MoF) in collaboration with the Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education (MBSSE) announces for the attention of the General Public that, as part of its commitment to financing the Free Quality Education, Government has made a total payment of Le52,540,460,000.00 as tuition fees for pupils in Pre-Primary, Primary, Junior and Senior Secondary Schools in Government and Government-Assisted Schools for the first term of 2021/2022 school year.

The Ministry wishes to further inform the public that these payments have been made directly into the bank accounts of beneficiary schools based on the approved school list and enrolment data submitted by the Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education to the Ministry of Finance.

The Ministry of Finance further wishes to inform the General Public that payment for 53 Senior Secondary Schools were withheld pending investigations by MBSSE and the Anti-Corruption Commission on allegation of overstating the number of candidates for the payment of WASSCE fees made to WAEC for the ongoing examination.

Government has also paid Le462 million to 15 Special Needs Schools across the country for Quarter 3 of 2021, while payment process for Quarter 4 of similar amount is in progress.
