The Ministry of Lands, Housing and Country Planning (MLHCP) wishes to inform the General Public that the Committee on Land Conflict and Resolutions has submitted its report to His Excellency the President. The report will be tabled in cabinet and thereafter made public.

In the meantime, the Public is hereby informed that the Moratorium on the lease or sale of State Lands and Freehold is lifted with immediate effect.

The Ministry of Lands, Housing and Country Planning will resume processing of backlog documents on Land Administration and Management on the following dates:

1. Freehold - 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021
2. Conveyance – 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021
3. Survey Plans – 9<sup>th</sup> November 2021

All new applications for State Lands will be considered when all backlogs are cleared.

The MLHCP also wishes to inform the General Public that another model for the sale of State Lands has been approved by Cabinet and it will soon be made public

The Ministry of Lands, Housing and Country Planning assures the Sierra Leonean Public of an effective and efficient Land Administration and Management.
