

PRESS RELEASE

Following our previous press release dated the 28th October 2021 with reference to allegations made by

Dennis Amara Turay Jalloh (Kao Denero) on Afriradio 105.3 FM accusing the Sierra Leone Djs Union

(SLeDU) of being Political and also linking the union's activities to be politically motivated by the All

Peoples Congress (APC), a 48 hours ultimatum was given to Kao Denero Sierra Leone's Special Envoy on

Entertainment & Investment to provide evidence to substantiate the claims he made against the Sierra

Leone Dis union.

Since he has failed to provide the evidence (s) within the stipulated period, the union is left with no other

option but to seek redress for such unprofessional utterances he made against the union on radio.

Whiles we explore further actions, the Sierra Leone Djs Union with immediate effect place a BAN on all

songs done by Kao Denero until further notice. SLeDU members within and outside Sierra Leone are

hereby directed not to play any of Kao Denero's songs effective today the 1st November 2021.

We will keep the general public informed about further actions as we continue to pursue all available

means in seeking clarity on the unfortunate statement by Kao Denero as it is not only demeaning but also

has the potential to put our Members (Djs) at risk whiles executing their duties because they have been

branded APC supporters.

In less than one year of his appointment, Ambassador has caused more division than unifying the

entertainment industry.
