I hereby refer your Lordship, The Chairman, **Judicial Legal Service Commission** to the above cited subject and to inform you that several allegations in form of complaints have been lodged to **His Excellency The President**, against The **Auditor General Mrs Lara Taylor-Pearce** and her Deputy, Mr Tamba Momoh amounting to misconduct or lack of professional performance while in office.

Based on the above allegations, Learned Chief Justice, I draw your attention to subsection (9) of section 119 of The Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991, Act No. 6 of 1991 (hereinafter referred to as The Constitution) which refers to the process of their removal from office to Section 137 of The Constitution which requires among other conditions precedent to their removal, representation by The Judicial and Legal Service Commission to the president pursuant to Subsection (5) of Section 137 of The Constitution.
