Enumeration on the field has continued, largely unhindered, save for the pockets of resistance we are still experiencing in some parts of the country.

We want to also appreciate the support we are getting from the Office for National Security (ONS) and the Sierra Leone Police at Karene district who today held a meeting with the district officials and other MDAs aimed at garnering support and engaging community leaders for increased participation for the Mid Term Census in the district.

The conference was geared towards canvassing support from civil society organisations, Religious leaders, Community Based Organisations, The Media and others.
