Following the public pronouncement on the increase in the pump price of fuel per litre for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene from **Le 10,000** to **Le 12,000**, the General Public is hereby informed that the Ministry of Transport and Aviation in collaboration with the Motor Drivers Union and other Key Stakeholders in the Transport Sector have agreed as follows for public transportation fares (**LE**) within the Freetown Municipality and the Provincial/Across-Border Routes effective *Tuesday 1st March, 2022*:
