President Julius Maada Bio Unveils Le. 5.3 Billion Community Development Agreement Fund

His Excellency, President, Dr Julius Maada Bio has unveiled a cash amount of Le 5.3 billion, paid into the accounts of the Community Development Agreement (CDA), Fund by Kingho Mining Company, a subsidiary of Leone Rock Metals, saying that it is a bold step to support the development of mining communities. The event was held at the Mining Company's Ferengbeya Mining Site, Tonkolili District on Tuesday 24th May 2022

"I am very pleased to be here to formally launch this Community Development Agreement payment to local community stakeholders. It aligns with my vision of formalising and regularising how mining communities can substantially benefit from mining activities in their areas" he said.

President Bio also emphasised that he believed stakeholders and decision-makers could do better for mining communities, adding that increasing community development agreement payments from 0.01% of annual revenue in the previous operation year to 1% during mining operations was in the best interests of mining communities.

Chief Executive Officer of the Kingho Mining Company, Gilbert Zhao, said it was a great honour to work with the people of Tonkolili who were now getting what they truly deserved, adding that the company would continue to look into the concerns of the people for a greater working relationship.

Host Paramount Chief of Dansogoya

Chiefdom, PC Alimamy Bockarie Yalan Koroma III, said the amount was the highest any company had paid since the discovery of iron ore in Tonkolili in 2010. "Your Excellency, this is the first time such an amount is ever paid to the community. We want to thank you for providing such caring leadership".

President Bio opens New Magbele Bridge



His Excellency President, Julius Maada Bio, commissioned the 48 million Euros (Le 634 billion) Magbele Bridge in the Rogbere Community, Port Loko District, on Saturday 14th May 2022, saying that the 163-meter-long modern two-lane bridge, now provides a safer corridor for trade and commerce. He officially renamed the new bridge, Pa Adikali Modu III Bridge.
