

Leone Rock Metal Group (LRMG) Company Limited until recently was known as Kingho Investment Company Limited. It was established in Sierra Leone in July 2010. It is a registered Company in Sierra Leone under the company's Act No.5 of 2009 as a company with registration number SLE290716KINGH1600235.

Leone Rock Metal Group Company Limited is one of the largest resource investment companies in West Africa. The company, till today, is parent company of Kingho Mining Company and Kingho Railway & Port Company which are part of an integrated Iron Ore Mining-Railway-Port Handling and export group of companies.

The asset encompasses an open pit Iron Ore Mine and surface operations located in Ferengbeya, Tonkolili and a 192 KM Railway and an integrated train discharge, ore processing and ship loading Port located in Pepel, Northwest Sierra Leone.

The company acquired the Tonkolili mines in January 2020, with proven reserves of 13.8 billion tons. So far, Kingho Mining Company has obtained a total of 18.8 billion tons of proven iron ore reserves and prospective 30 billion + tons Iron Ore Resource upon further exploration.

Kingho Mining Company Limited undertakes a sustainable mining project that not only contribute to the development of the localities within its operational areas, it also maintains an all-round compliance approach that will maintain continuous stakeholders and community engagement process as the project evolves into various stages.

In January 2021, Kingho Railway and Port Company Limited another subsidiary company signed a lease agreement with the Government of Sierra Leone to operate and manage the railway and Pepel port. The company's rail corridor passes through Bombali, Karene and Port Loko district where the port is located.

'We are confident to keep investing in Sierra Leone'- China Kingho Energy Group Assures



President of China Kingho Energy Group, Colin Ding, has assured the President and people of the Republic of Sierra Leone that his company is confident to keep investing in Sierra Leone.

Colin Ding made this commitment on Tuesday 24th May 2022 at a well-attended and coordinated gathering in the Kingho Mining Company's site at Ferengbeya, Tonkolili District, Northern Province of Sierra Leone. The gathering had His Excellency President Julius Maada Bio as the guest of honour and also saw guests such as government ministers, members of parliaments, Heads of MDAs, security personnel, and public and private sector officials, who were in Tonkolili to mark the launching of the first payment of Mining Company's the Kingho Community Development Agreement (CDA) Fund to the mining communities across its operational areas in the district.

In the area of production capacity, Colin Ding confirmed that the company is currently installing "our tailings optimization plant which will help us produce and export +62% Iron concentrate. This ambition is not a forecast but a plan being implemented now for you to see, and I hope before the end of this year, His Excellency the President will be at Tonkolili Iron Ore Project to commission the optimisation plant which will help us export +62% Iron concentrate from our tailings." He thanked the Government of Sierra Leone for creating a conducive and enabling environment for more investment into the country.

Installation of Phase 2 Processing Plant Nearly Complete



The phase 2 processing plant construction project was launched early this year with the aim of creating a beneficiation plant that will concentrate and optimize the tailings from the tailings storage facility (TSF) to 62% iron (Fe) concentrate to make the company's product will be globally competitive.

So far, good progress was made. The project feasibility study, design, equipment procurement, and project construction were completed. It is expected to be completed and put into production on August 31.

As at the end of June 2022, 95% of civil infrastructure has been completed and 60% of steel structure installation has been completed. Production will kick start in Q3 2022.

RAILWAY OPERATION

Commissioning New Locomotives to boost Ore Haulage 利昂洛克金属集团提量增产新机车投运仪式

The Railway Department of Leone Rock Metal Group is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the 192-kilometer railway from the Port of Pepel to the Tonkolili Iron Ore Mines. At present, the subcontracting mode is adopted, and four subcontractors are involved. CCECC is responsible for rail track maintenance, CRRC is responsible for wagons restoration and maintenance, Grindrod is responsible for locomotives and railway operation and Africell is responsible for telecommunications transmission of radios.

From January to the end of June 2022, the railway transported a total of 436 trips with a total of 3.04 million tons of iron ore.

Sierra Leone's President Maada Bio Commissions 3 Brand New Kingho Railway Locomotives

Sierra Leone's President His Excellency President Julius Maada Bio has commissioned three (3) brand new locomotives to enable Kingho Mining Company haulage its iron ore from the New Tonkolili Iron Ore Mines in Ferengbey, Tonkolili District to the port of Pepel in Port Loko District.





Speaking during the commissioning ceremony at the Train Load Out (TLO), Jay Chen, Deputy General Manager of Kingho Railway and Port Company said that when the company took over in 2020, the rail system was not operational at all. He added that the company made enormous efforts and invested a huge sum of money for the restoration of the railway facilities.

It is worth noting that the locomotive is a rail transport vehicle that provides the motive power for a train. A single locomotive has the capacity to pull 30 wagons which are used to transport iron ore from the mines to the port. So far, the train sets 112 wagons to 4 locomotives and 90 wagons to 3 locomotives.

The commissioning of three additional locomotives by the President himself will improve the haulage capacity of the company to achieve a target of 25,200 tonnes daily and 9 million tonnes annually.

PORT OPERATION

In the first half of 2022, 17 CAPE vessels were chartered, 16 were shipped, 316 barges were loaded and ttl quantity was 3208015.88MT

Success of Freight in 6 month

The exported volume were gradually increased and adjusted appropriately according to the fluctuation of iron ore price.

The average freight rate of our chartered vessels in the first half of 2022 is almost same with the average value of C3 index, the price difference between our freight rate and C3 index in the first half of 2022 was gradually reduced.

Seven cooperative partners in the first half of 2022, including five new cooperative partners except BRS and TOPSAIL, new inquiry partners are not included for the time being.

Discharging Port Update

A total of 6 vessels were discharged to two ports, with a 100% demurrage ratio; 10 vessels were discharged to one port, with a 50% demurrage ratio.

A total of 13 vessels were discharged to the northern ports (including ports within the Yangtze River), with a demurrage ratio of approximately 70%; 3 vessels were discharged to the southern ports, with a demurrage ratio of approximately 30%.




Transshipping Platform at Outer Anchorage

LRMG's Compliance Unit Embarks on Internal HSE & Operational Regulatory Compliance Audit

As part of its responsibility in keeping LRMG and its subsidiaries compliant to statutory provisions, the Compliance Unit, in the Office of the CEO, embarked on its 1st Quarter Internal HSE and Operational Regulatory Compliance audit during the first week of April, 2022.


The audit exercise covered LRMG's operations at the Tonkolili Iron Ore (TIO) Mine, operated by Kingho Mining Company and the Port & Rail operations, superintended by Kingho Railway & Port Company. At TIO Mine, the audit targeted Kingho Mining Company and its key Contractors (CRSG and Huaxin, including their respective Sub-Contractors), whilst at the Port & Rail side, the audit was mainly centred on Kingho Railway & Port Company and several major Contractors such as CCECC, Grinrod and Ocean Favor.



The audit was divided into four(4) thematic areas; Safety Culture, Health & Sanitation, Environmental Management & General Operational/Production Controls. In consonant with the statutory instruments governing the mineral industy, each of these areas, were further devided into discrete sub-sets which were probed into to measure the compliance levels of the aforementioned companies.







The audit revealed that KMC & KRP are making steady progress in most of the regulatory units, especially on Health & Sanitation and Environmental Management. It also shows that some of the contractors are taking strides to improve on their operational regulatory compliance. On the Contractors side, Grinrod was deemed the most compliant as depicted by the score card above. However, continuous improvement was advised for all, in order to keep both sites at the highest standards of operational compliance.

Leone Rock Metal Group Pays over Le 1.3 Billion Surface Rent for Its Licenses in Tonkolili District

Leone Rock Metal Group has paid a total amount of over Le 1,300,000,000 (one billion three hundred million Leones) as surface rent to landowners within its Iron Ore licenses in Tonkolili District, Northern Province of the Republic of Sierra Leone.

The payment of the surface rents by the company is pursuant to the requirement for the granting of a Large-Scale Mining License and in relation to Leone Rock Metal Group's obligation prescribed in Section 34(a) of the Mines and Minerals Act 2009 for surface rent.



During the payment, Paramount Chief Alimamy Bockarie Yallan Koroma of Dansogoia Chiefdom, reechoed the voices of the landowners and Paramount Chiefs of all the concessions by saying that the payment of the surface rent shows that Leone Rock is sensitive to its obligations. He thanked the company and prayed that the relationship between the company and the people continue to bolster.


