

RE: USE OF PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED NAMES IN CONTRAVENTION TO SECTION 28(1) (C) COMPANIES ACT 2009

It has come to the notice of Corporate Affairs Commission that Consortium of Progressive Political Parties was erroneously incorporated and registered on the 20th June 2022, as a company limited by guarantee without the requisite approval from the appropriate authorities for use of the words 'Political' and 'Parties'. This is in contravention to Section 28 (1) (C) which reads:

"No company shall be incorporated or registered under this Act by a name which in the opinion of the Commission is capable of misleading as to the nature or extent of its activities or is undesirable, offensive or otherwise contrary to public policy"

We therefore withdraw our approval for use of the aforementioned prohibited names and ask that the Certificates of Incorporation and Registration be returned to Corporate Affairs Commission.
