## REVISED TRAVEL GUIDELINES

The Presidential Task Force (PTF) on COVID-19 has directed that COVID-19 testing for inbound and outbound passengers is withdrawn until further notice. In this regard, the Ministry of Health and Sanitation announces the following revised COVID-19 guidelines, which comes into effect at 12:00 midnight (GMT) on Friday, 8th July, 2022:

- 1. All inbound and outbound passengers MUST register on the travel portal www.travel.gov.sl before travelling into or out of Sierra Leone.
- 2. All inbound and outbound passengers 12 years and above are strongly encouraged to be fully vaccinated at least fourteen (14) days prior to travel.
- 3. Fully vaccinated inbound and outbound passengers with valid proof of COVID-19 vaccination will no longer be required to take a pre-departure or pre-arrival COVID-19

The public is reminded that the COVID-19 pandemic is not yet over and it is in the interest of all to continue wearing face mask as appropriate, maintain hand hygiene, practice social distancing, and be fully vaccinated.
