REVISED TRAVEL GUIDELINES

The Presidential Task Force (PTF) on COVID-19 has directed that COVID-19 testing for inbound and outbound passengers is withdrawn until further notice. In this regard, the Ministry of Health and Sanitation announces the following revised COVID-19 guidelines, which comes into effect at **12:00 midnight (GMT)** on Friday, 8th July, 2022:

1. All inbound and outbound passengers **MUST** register on the travel portal www.travel.gov.sl before travelling into or out of Sierra Leone.
2. All inbound and outbound passengers 12 years and above are strongly encouraged to be fully vaccinated at least fourteen (14) days prior to travel.
3. Fully vaccinated inbound and outbound passengers with valid proof of COVID-19 vaccination will no longer be required to take a pre-departure or pre-arrival COVID-19 PCR test.

The public is reminded that the COVID-19 pandemic is not yet over and it is in the interest of all to continue wearing face mask as appropriate, maintain hand hygiene, practice social distancing, and be fully vaccinated.
