

This Notice of Appeal dated the 18<sup>th</sup> December 2020 coming up for hearing on this day before the Hon. Mr. Justice M. P. Mammie – Justice of Appeal (Presiding); the Hon. Mrs. Justice Tonia Barnett, Justice of Appeal; the Hon. Mr. Justice A. K. Musa – Judge of the High Court; in the presence of Yada Hashim Williams esq. of Counsel for the Appellant and Ms. Abigail Suwu and the Appellant having abandoned grounds 1, 2 and 3 of his Notice of Appeal.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the following Orders were made:

1. That the finding of the Sole Commissioner, Justice Biobele Georgewill that the Appellant should return to the Government of Sierra Leone the total number of 254 vehicles and motorbikes that were used by the National Emergency Response Center during the fight of the EBOLA crisis in Sierra Leone but not handed over by the Appellant to the Office of National Security at the close of operations of the National Emergency Response Center cannot be supported by the evidence adduced before this Court and is therefore set aside.
2. That contrary to the Sole Commissioner's findings in his report, all the said 254 vehicles and motorbikes were fully accounted for by the Appellant as they were all handed over to the Office of National Security at the close of operations of the National Emergency Response Center.
3. That the adverse findings and recommendations of the Sole Commissioner against the Appellant as contained in his report cannot be supported by the evidence adduced before him and before this Court and are therefore overturned.
