

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND AVIATION PUBLIC NOTICE

The Public will recall that a Public Notice from the Ministry of Transport and Aviation published in both print and electronic media between 5th and 10th September 2022 informed of a Cabinet sub-committee, chaired by the chief Minister, tasked to investigate claims and counter claims to ownership of piece and parcels of lands in and around the Hastings Airfield area. Furthermore, the Ministry of Transport and Aviation requested all claimants to any piece and parcels of land at the aforementioned area to submit all relevant documents justifying such claims to the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Country Planning.

The general public is hereby informed that, since the publication of the Public Notice under reference, the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Country Planning has only received one response from the public. Consequently, the Ministry of Transport and Aviation is hereby notifying all occupiers of any portion or parcel of land in and around the Hastings Airfield area to vacate same by Monday, 31st October 2022 as the Government of Sierra Leone will take full possession of all such land on Tuesday, 1st November 2022.

All are advised to heed to the contents of this public notice, otherwise will have themselves to be blamed for the consequences leading to repossession of all parcels of land in and around the Hastings Airfield.
